Position Summary

The Aloha Foundation is seeking qualified Assistant Chefs for our residential summer camps and Dining Services Department. These positions include a competitive salary, room and board, and the ability to spend the summer in a lakeside setting in Vermont. The Assistant Chef directs the kitchen including and not limited to assisting the Head Chef order food, planning menus, overseeing staff and volunteers and food preparation. Our Assistant Chef is a person who works well with others, plans ahead, is disciplined in spending and makes good food. They must have experience cooking and ideally experience running a kitchen.

The Assistant Chef positions offer the opportunity to be part of a team preparing quality meals in a positive, friendly environment while enriching children's lives. The camp season begins in early June and ends August 21, 2022. Assistant Chefs can receive opportunity to join the Aloha Foundations year-round Dining Services Department.

Key Responsibilities

- Assist in the preparation of meals for approximately 250 campers and staff including special events
- Assist with purchasing and receiving food and supplies
- Maintain food quality and safety
- Kitchen cleaning
- Prepare, cook, clean, guide others – the kitchen is your domain
- Work closely with Kitchen Assistants and supervise food production
- Know sanitation and abide by VT Health Regulations
- Practice and teach sanitation training for all involved in food service



Qualifications

- Cooking: 3 years preferred
- Restaurant: 1 year preferred
- Experience with food preparation including cooking and plating meals
- The ability to carry out tasks quickly and competently
- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds unassisted
- The ability to work a full shift, come to work on time
- The ability to work according to the necessary schedule to meet job requirements
