Position Summary

We are seeking four individuals interested in a live-in childcare position. The job is from June 13th to August 12th at traditional overnight summer camps on beautiful Lake Morey in Fairlee, VT. This is a truly beautiful place to spend a summer – a gorgeous lake with cool breezes, nestled within the pine trees.

Key Responsibilities

You would share in the childcare of four children, ages 2-7 while their parents work on campus. Hours are approximately 9 am to 5 pm, six days per week. Room and Board (three prepared meals a day), weekly laundry service, provided uniform and the chance to care for children in a community and without the isolation of a traditional nanny position.

Requirements - Knowledge, Qualifications, Skills, Abilities

- Experience working with children ages 2-7.
- Comfort on, in, and near the water.
- CPR and Lifeguard training (preferred).
- Willingness to work outside most of the day.
- Willingness to live on campus.
- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Driver's license (preferred)
- Strong interpersonal skills, including an upbeat, collaborative approach.
- Organizational and time management skills.
- Hard-working, enthusiastic, and committed to the safety and well-being of children.
