Friday, July 20

7:00 p.m. Performance / dress rehearsal of *Madagascar*. Parents are welcome to attend the dress rehearsal and should plan to arrive after dinner and meet their camper outside the Comb.

Leaving camp property: Campers may travel to Aloha or Lanakila to visit siblings during appropriate times (Saturday 10-4 and Sunday 10-2). Otherwise, it is the established policy of The Aloha Camps that campers should not be taken out of camp for any reason. The policy has been adopted in what we believe to be the best interest of the campers. We ask your cooperation in requesting no exceptions. All campers are expected to be in their own camp for the 7:00 pm Saturday performances.

Swim Check & Boating Procedures

Swim Check: Visitors are required to complete a swim check in order to swim at Hive on Show Weekend (Swim two laps, tread water for 2 minutes).

Boating: You may use the boats and canoes in the boating area, but a Type II Personal Flootation Device (PFD) must be worn by anyone who has not completed their swim check. Boaters who have completed their swim check may wear a Type III jacket-style PDF. Visitors may only go out in a sailboat with a member of the Sailing Department aboard.
