Friday, July 20

Leaving camp property: Campers may travel to Aloha or Hive to visit siblings during appropriate times (Saturday 10-4 and Sunday 10-2). Otherwise, it is the established policy of The Aloha Camps that campers should not be taken out of camp for any reason. The policy has been adopted in what we believe to be the best interest of the campers. We ask your cooperation in requesting no exceptions. All campers are expected to be in their own camp for the 7:00 pm Saturday performances.

Swim Check & Boating Procedures

- Swim Check:** We require a swim check for deep water swimming (Swim two laps, tread water for 2 minutes). Visitors who are unable to complete this check may swim in the slide area, but may not go into deep water.
- Boating:** You may use the boats and canoes in the boating area, but a Personal Flootation Device (PFD) must be worn at all times.
- Sailing:** Visitors may sail after successfully completing the Swim Check and only with a sailing department member aboard. Everyone must wear a PFD.
