



## **Kitchen Assistants at Ohana Family Camp**

We are looking for kitchen assistants to work at the Ohana Family Camp on Lake Fairlee. These are seasonal, full-time and part-time positions that run from May through October. Pay is commensurate with experience. The responsibilities of the kitchen assistants include:

- Dining hall set-up prior to each meal
- Helping with meal preparation
- Baking desserts and snacks
- Maintain clean and organized work spaces
- Follow sanitation policies and procedures
- Kitchen clean-up including sweeping and mopping floors and helping dishwasher during peak times
- Perform other duties as needed

The ideal candidate has a great attitude and is looking to be part of a team willing to create memorable experiences for the guests and themselves.

Ohana Family Camp is part of the Aloha Foundation, a non-profit organization, and is located on Lake Fairlee in east-central Vermont. Our summer family camp season runs June 17 - August 22. We also cater weddings and events, so longer employment is available for up to 6 months, from May - October.

During the summer, we serve 3 meals a day, buffet style, and cater to several food allergies and preferences. On average, we serve approximately 115 people per meal per day. Spring and fall vary from buffet to family style to formal plated meals and numbers range 50-175. We work with local farms and producers to source our food, including from our herb gardens, vegetable patches, and foraged goods. Our kitchen is bright and open which means we frequently interact with campers who like to watch us cook and prep. This is a fun and pleasant work environment. We work long hours in one of the most beautiful places on earth with incredible people. And there are no late nights—we are usually out between 8 - 9 pm. This job is unlike any kitchen job you will ever have!
