Picnic

Please bring a nut-free picnic lunch to enjoy on camp property. Many of you will bring special treats from home, but for those of you planning to purchase a picnic locally, we highly recommend ordering your lunch the day before. Swim Check & Boating Procedures

Swim Check: A swim check is required for deep water swimming (swim 2 laps, tread water for 2 minutes). Visitors who are unable to complete this test may swim in the shallow area, but may not go into the deep water.

Boating: You may use the boats and canoes in the waterfront, but a Personal Flotation Device (PFD) must be worn at all times.

Sailing: Visitors may sail after successfully completing the Swim Check and only with a sailing department member aboard. Everyone must wear a PFD.

Leaving Camp Property

Campers with siblings at other Aloha camps may sign out to go with their families to visit those campuses. Campers must return to their own camp by 8:45 pm on Saturday and by 2 pm on Sunday. Otherwise, it is the Aloha Foundation's policy that campers should not leave camp premises for any reason. We have adopted this policy in what we believe to be the best interest of the campers. We ask for your cooperation in requesting no exceptions.
