Position Summary

Horizons Day Camp is seeking several full-time and part-time seasonal kitchen assistants for our summer camp season. The season begins mid-June and ends mid-August. This is an ideal position for an applicant who is considering a career in food service. The kitchen assistant performs a number of kitchen activities including pot washing, dish washing, light food prep, general cleaning duties, and storing food and non-food supplies.

The salary status is non-exempt, thereby you are entitled to be paid overtime for work in excess of 40 hours per week.

Key Responsibilities

- Wash dishes, utensils, and pots.
- Operate dish washing equipment.
- Distribute and store clean pots, dishes, and utensils.
- Clean and sanitize production equipment, work surfaces and kitchen according to cleaning schedules and procedures.
- Maintain assigned workstation in a safe and sanitary condition.
- Maintain acceptable standards of personal hygiene and complies with department dress code.
- Follow safety regulations, report injuries or any unsafe conditions and work practices to the supervisor.
- Empty trash containers as required.

Requirements - Knowledge, Qualifications, Skills, Abilities

- A high school diploma or equivalent is required.
- Ability to read, speak, write, and understand English. Follow directions and complete tasks.
- Ability to follow time schedules for meal preparation and serving.
- Maintains a neat, clean, well-groomed appearance.
- Dependable, with experience working in facilities utilizing quantity food production methods.
- Previous experience preferred but not required. Will train on the job.
- Fundamental understanding of sanitation, cleanliness, and personal hygiene.
- Regular, predictable, and reliable attendance.
- Must be able to lift/carry a maximum of 50 pounds, push/pull a maximum of 50 pounds, stand, sit, bend and walk for extended periods of time.
- Must be able to work around food and cleaning products.
